**Code Enforcement** – A total of 125 code-enforcement reports, most with multiple actions, were taken by police officers for the month of November. The hard-copy report is available upon request to Board Members. Below is a sample:

**Grants Activity** – The Department received notice it is being awarded \$6,779.00 (75% match) by the Illinois Criminal Justice Authority to purchase two state-of-the-art digital in-car video systems and an automated downloader. The Village will match that amount with \$2,261.00 (25%), which will be paid from Special Enforcement Funds (restricted use fund).

Currently 8 of 11 police vehicles have in-car camera systems. In-car camera systems are a proven tool in providing evidence in DUI enforcement cases for court, investigating allegations of misconduct by the public against a police officer, and in providing evidence in civil (tort) actions brought against the Department.



**Automated Traffic Enforcement** – The “approval rate” by the Department, which is always less than the “sent” rate from the vendor, rose slightly from September into October.

**Archive Records Disposal** – In accordance with State Statute the Police Department requested and was authorized to destroy printed police records and reports. Over 27 boxes (350 pounds) of paper documents were shredded on-site by a selected vendor. All reports and documents are maintained electronically on a digital medium.

**Navy Escort** – As with last year, the Moose Lodge hosted 2 bus loads of Navy personnel from the Base. The Police and Fire Departments escorted them into town, from Fairfield and 176 to the Lodge.
